Sustainability Statement

Fleet Luxury Print Limited hold ISO 14001 certification and continue to be fully committed to minimising the effect our manufacturing processes have on the environment. We believe that responsible, ethical and professional business practice should be central to all our operations, and day to day business activities.

- We only use FSC® certified paper. This guarantees 100% of the wood fibre has been sourced from sustainably managed forests and other controlled sources, and it's site of origin is proven and traceable under FSC certification. We encourage the use of 100% and part recycled paper where possible.
- Fleet Luxury is FSC certified under license code FSC C129615. This enables our customers to continue the FSC chain of evidence through their printed products, should they choose to do so.
- We use Carbon Balanced Paper, offering our clients a simple, valid and measurable way to reduce carbon impacts of printed media and communications through conservation projects undertaken by World Land Trust.
- Our house paper stock does not use chlorine in the bleaching process and is produced in European mills meeting the highest environmental standards.
- We have further reduced our use of chemicals by investing in chemistry free plate processing.
- We use vegetable based lithographic printing inks and we do not use petroleum inks.
- We sort and recycle our waste paper and our cardboard. We recycle our printing plates and our waste ink is re-milled into black ink for use as newspaper ink and as fuel to start blast furnaces.

- Wherever possible we use paper-based packaging instead of plastics. All plastic protective wrapping from paper pallets is bailed into 100kg bails. The bailed plastic along with all plastic containers is then collected and recycled.
- Our pallet wrap is made from part recycled plastic and it gives extra yield as it can be stretched further so we use less.
- We launder our rags and recycle our ink tins & lids. These are specially stacked for maximum uplift.
- All waste is segregated, collected and recycled by accredited waste disposal experts, ensuring disposal in the most environmentally sensitive way.
- We have transitioned company vehicles to electric ones and any new or replacement vehicles will be electric.
- We have installed low energy light bulbs.
- We do not use disposable cups, we wash our cups and glasses. We recycle any drinks cans or glass bottles.
- Our wooden pallets are reused and even our broken pallets are turned into bee hives, or nesting boxes for birds and insects.
- We took an existing watch box from one of our clients made from mdf, plastic and metal and created a watch box made from 100% recycled material that is 100% recyclable.
- We use recycling schemes to recycle toner cartridges and drums on our office printers and copier.
- Avoid unnecessary travel by making use of instant messaging, video and audio conferencing, telephone and email.
